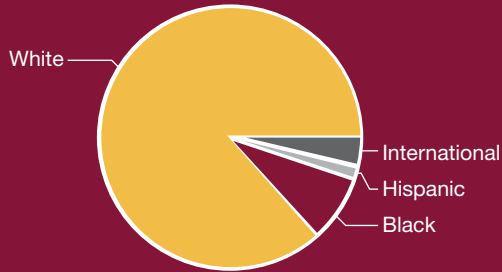

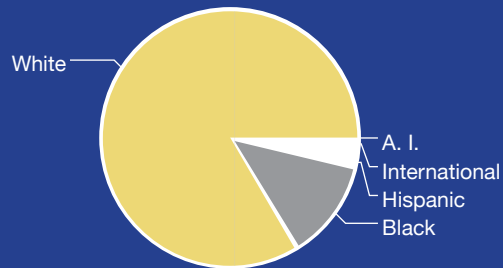

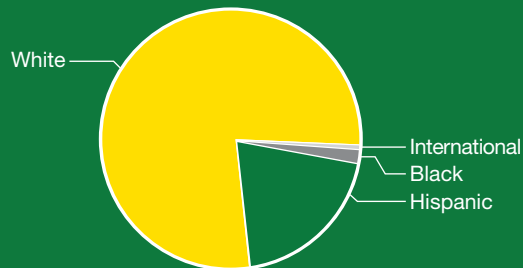

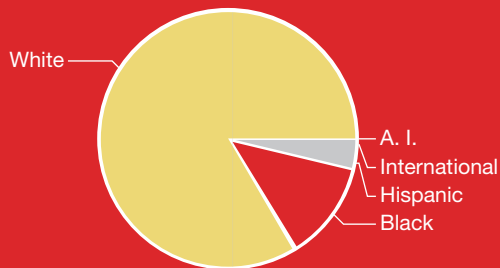


Cardinal Mooney High School
