  - Understand how to meet the expectations of test creators
  - Gain a sense of certainty and confidence by familiarizing themselves with the format of the tests



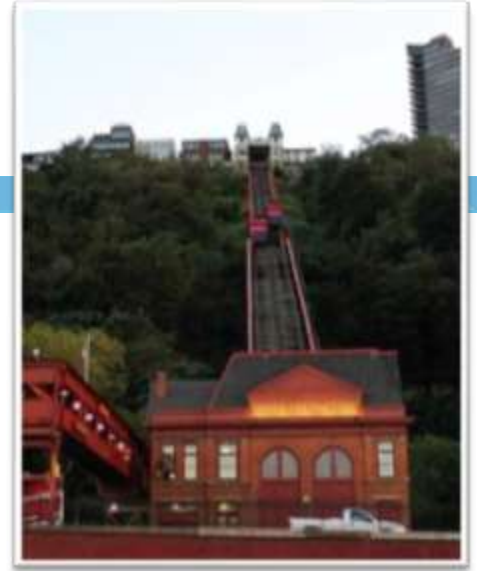
