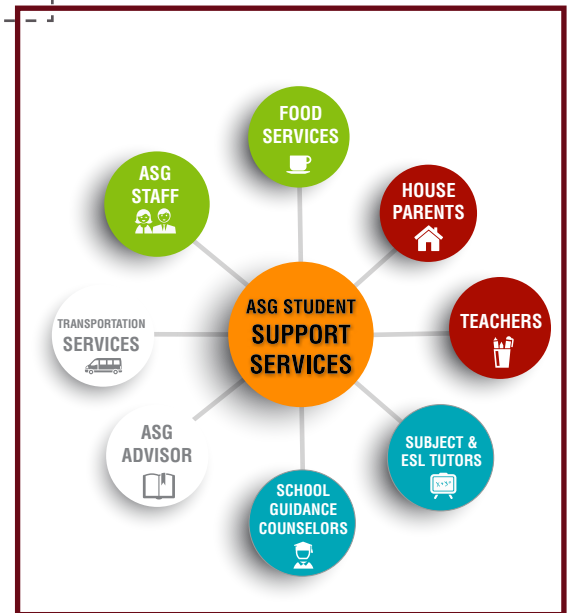

ASG is represented by **23** high school, middle school, and university partnerships, capable of accepting students from **7th to 12th** grade and at the university level (**12-24 years old**).

ASG programs range from 2-4 week immersion camps to long-term high school and university study programs.

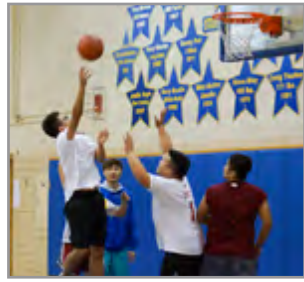

ASG Students are provided transportation to their schools and school-related functions by certified & licensed drivers daily. Transportation is also provided for all ASG events and trips. Students can also request transportation to desired destinations.

All ASG drivers are licensed in Pennsylvania and Ohio, with a number of members certified by the National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB).

> Dining

ASG Students are served **two meals** daily

Weekdays: Breakfast & Dinner

Weekends: Brunch & Dinner

3 days a week, students are served **American meals**, with **Asian-themed meals** served on the other days. This planned arrangement ensures that a taste of home is preserved for the student's experience at ASG.

All ASG dining staff and houseparents undergo constant cooking training to ensure that they are capable of preparing meals from a variety of cultures.



Formal Dining

Every month, a formal dining event is held for all ASG Staff and Students. A total of **8 special dining events** are held every year, each with its own special theme and purpose. Speakers are invited and students are recognized for monthly achievements. These programs help students learn and experience the best of American and international culture. > Student Engagement

ASG Advising Program

Each ASG Student is assigned an ASG advisor whom they meet regularly to discuss any ongoing issues and challenges. Advisors and students are matched by similar interests and preferences.

ASG Advisors:

- Keep track of their students' academic progress, attendance, and conduct at school and ASG
- Serve as liaisons between schools and ASG to help students select their classes, communicate concerns, and facilitate any necessary requests.
- Help students create objectives and develop a plan for achieving them.
- Provide students career and university counseling, develop their resumes, prepare for interviews, and compile their college application materials.
- Recommend programs students should take advantage of at school and ASG to maximize their academic and cultural experience.

ASG students are provided mandatory structured tutoring Mondays to Thursdays for homework assistance, **SAT, ESL & TOEFL prep**.

Students who fall behind in school are identified early and given the support they need to get back on track.

Tutors & Advisors work closely with schools to track students' academic progress weekly.

Accelerated & Honors Programs

Particularly driven and successful students have the opportunity to take advantage of their time at ASG. These students can take college-in-high school programs that will allow them to earn university-level credits. Students who start early can complete up to one academic year's worth of university-level credits.

Credit Recovery Programs

ASG's credit recovery program will help students who fall behind recover credit in classes they failed. Students will be paired with a tutor who will work closely with them to complete required coursework and pass their examinations.

Ivy Track

The Ivy Track is designed for the highest achieving students seeking admission to the top universities in America. Students enrolled in the program are provided a detailed selection of classes and recommended academic & extra-curricular programs tailored to meet admissions boards' criteria.

Partner Universities

ASG students are eligible to earn scholarships ranging from **US\$42,000 - US\$70,000** to attend any one of our partner universities: Thiel College, La Roche College, Gannon University, Westminster College

Optional Practical Training (OPT)

Upon completing their undergraduate education, all former ASG students can join an OPT internship program with ASG which will allow them to remain in America for up to 24 months. The ASG OPT internship program allows former ASG students to gain valuable work experience in their field of study.
