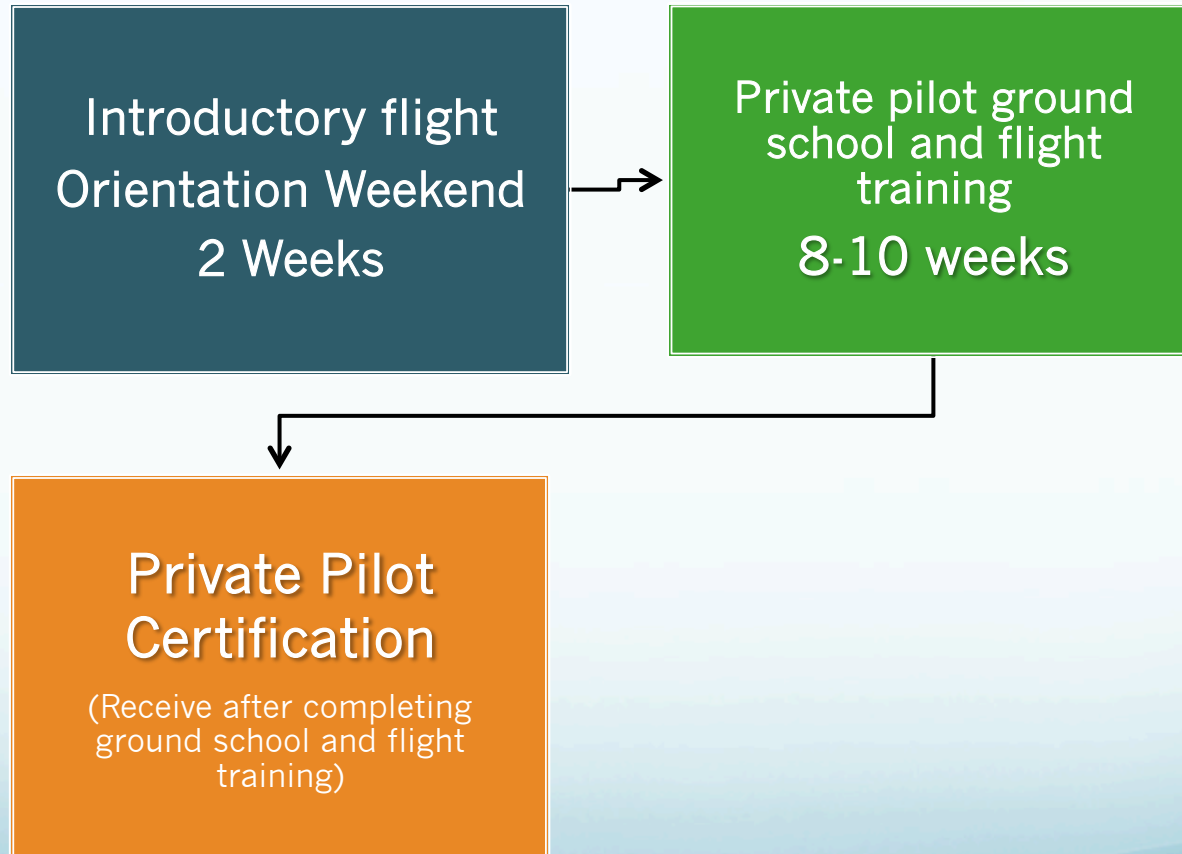

# You can begin Training at Any Age



# For pre-registration, students are required to have the following:

- VISA to enter the US (B1,F1)
- Passport
- Two forms of government-issued ID

# FAA Requirements

- read, write, speak, and understand English
- pass a **written knowledge test** with a score of at least 70%. Your ground instructor must “sign you off” to take the test.
- Pass **FAA physical exam** administered by an FAA approved doctor

# FAA Requirements

- Be at least **17 years of age** to sit for the FAA private pilot certification test.
- minimum of **40 hours** of flight instruction (20 with an instructor & 10 solo)

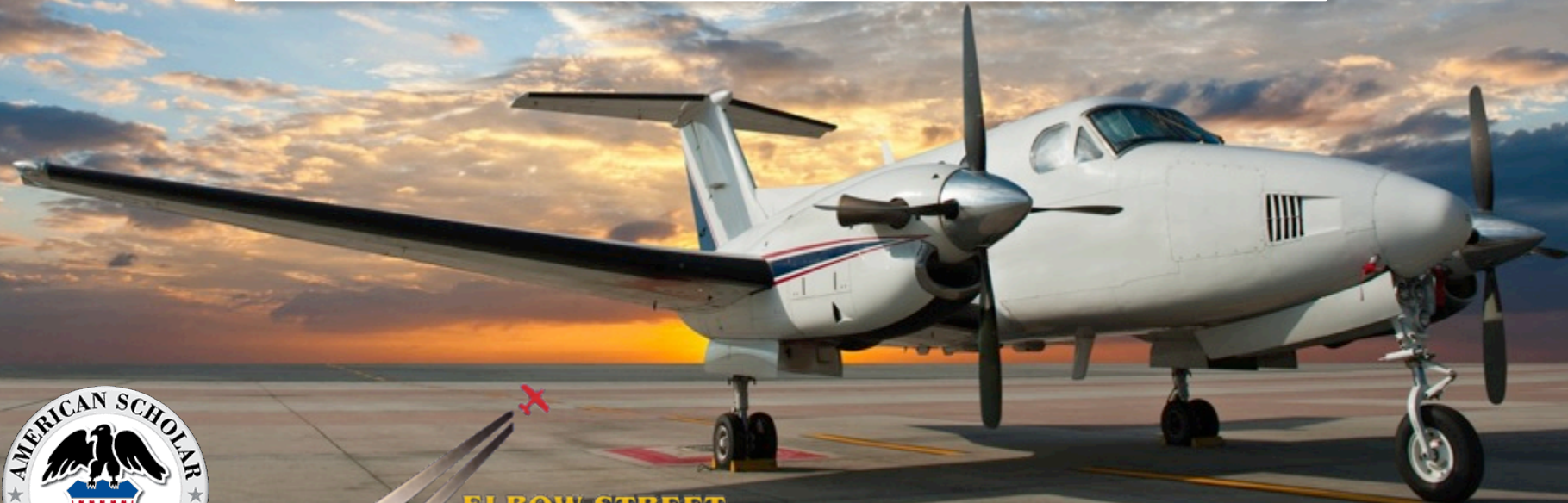
