




Fly day or night


Travel any distance

You can begin Training at Any Age



For pre-registration, students are required to have the following:

- > VISA to enter the US (B1,F1)
- Passport
- > Two forms of government-issued ID

FAA Requirements


- read, write, speak, and understand English
- > pass a written knowledge test with a score of at least 70%. Your ground instructor must "sign you off" to take the test.
- Pass FAA physical exam administered by an FAA approved doctor

FAA Requirements

- ➢ Be at least 17 years of age to sit for the FAA private pilot certification test.
- minimum of 40 hours of flight instruction (20 with an instructor & 10 solo)
