Large numbers of Jamestown students have also managed to qualify for the National Academic games—a glowing testament to the efforts of both teachers and students and no doubt a contribution to its high "Overachiever" ranking at 7th place among more than 500 other school districts. Ranked among the top 150 "most productive" districts in the nation by the Center for American Progress in a recent study, the nationally renown High School managed to clinch the 2013 Bronze Medal of "Best High School Nationally". The district also clinched the distinction in 2012, 2011, and 2009, and the Silver medal in 2012.










## Student Enrollment Distribution by Race / Ethnicity




